



## **LONDON DANCE AND CHEER ACADEMY (LDCA) Parent / Guardian Code of Conduct**

### **Effective Immediately**

London Dance and Cheer Academy (LDCA) is committed to providing a safe, positive, and respectful environment for all athletes, coaches, staff, and families.

Due to recent incidents, the following Code of Conduct is now in place and applies to all parents and guardians at **ALL** LDCA activities.

**Attendance at LDCA classes, camps, events, parties and competitions signifies acceptance of this Code of Conduct.**

### **Expected Behaviour**

Parents and guardians must:

- Treat all coaches, staff, school/venue staff, athletes, and other parents with respect at all times.
- Not shout at, intimidate, or use aggressive or inappropriate language toward any member of staff or the LDCA community.
- Allow coaches to do their job without interruption or interference.
- Raise any concerns calmly and through appropriate channels, not during classes or events.
- Support a positive environment and demonstrate kindness and good sportsmanship.
- Follow all rules set by LDCA and any host venues.

### **Failure to Comply**

LDCA operates a zero-tolerance approach to abuse or disrespectful behaviour.

Any breach of this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Immediate removal from a session or event
- Suspension from attending LDCA activities
- Termination of the athlete's place at LDCA in serious or repeated cases

**By continuing to attend LDCA activities, all parents and guardians agree to abide by this Code of Conduct.**
